Issue with canteen spending money We are aware that there has been some incidences of canteen spending money being taken from children's bags on the upper veranda of the school. These incidences have been off and on over the past 2 terms, unfortunately this type of incident does occur in schools. We have rules about children not going back to their bags during break times, however it can be difficult to ensure this is enforced. At this stage we are dealing with the issue in class, teachers are speaking with children about the rule, 'Be in the right place at the right time' and asking children to make sure their spending money is safely in a zipped pocket of their uniform or in a purse given to the teacher to mind inside the classroom. Children should not have a lot of money to spend as lunch orders are on QKR. I draw to your attention this information from the parent handbook, *Children do not need to bring more than \$2 cash to school for the canteen to purchase morning tea.* I will also be speaking to classes about honesty and continue to monitor the situation.
