# NAPLAN 2018 - recognition of our school by ACARA

Last week I received notification from ACARA (Australian curriculum assessment and reporting authority). This is the Australian education body who plan, deliver and monitor NAPLAN and the Australian curriculum for schools.

Our school has been identified as demonstrating substantially above average gain in student achievement in the NAPLAN numeracy test from 2018. This means the Year 5 of 2018 had substantial growth in their numeracy scores from Year 3 2016. This is a wonderful achievement for our school. It recognises the work over the last 5-6 years in teacher Professional Learning around understanding conceptual maths, teaching from student point of need identified via their growth points and students taking on a growth mindset in maths learning- well done all!

#### **Soccer Gala day**

On Tuesday the years 3 and 4 students participated in the Northern Beaches Catholic schools soccer gala day at Cromer Park. Today is the Year 5 and 6 gala day. Our Year 3 and 4 boys' championship team played so well, they were undefeated and were unlucky not to be awarded the winners trophy as another undefeated team beat us on for and against goals. Well done boys!

Thank you to Mrs Frost, Miss Preston, our teachers and parent volunteers who organised and managed teams on the day.
