A reminder that parents are now welcome to enter the school, for all drop offs, pick-ups etc. If you are entering the school please remember to check in using the QR code displayed all on the gates and all around the school. This means that as per our normal practice, if you are entering the school as a volunteer to work in the canteen, library or have a meeting with a teacher, (anything over 10 minutes) you need to come to the office and sign in at the Compass kiosk. This is so we can meet the contact tracing requirements.

Dear parents

Well here we are again, just before school holidays facing another Covid 19 crisis with increased restrictions. As per last year, I receive updates from our head office and then pass onto you. Often the restrictions for the public are different for schools. The advice below was current at 8am this morning and most of it is obsolete from 3pm this afternoon as children do not attend school tomorrow as it is our pupil free day.

COVID Updated Advice from Health NSW

All schools can continue to operate full-time on-site.

To minimise further spread of COVID-19 in these areas, parents are advised of the following changes for school activities during this time:

- Non-essential school visitors will not be allowed on school premises (ie: visitors not involved in delivering or supporting curricular activities)
- School-initiated non-curricular social activities (such as school discos and staff social events that involve members of the community in addition to staff and students) will be postponed where possible. Non-curricular activities and events held in school premises that involve members of the community in addition to students and staff must comply with the requirements of the current public health orders.
- Essential school visitors must continue to check-in via the QR code or sign in for each visit and comply with the school's COVID safe requirements, including personal hygiene, infection control and physical distancing requirements, while on the school site.
- Parents, carers and relatives may enter the school to drop off and pick up students in accordance with school COVIDsafe arrangements.

Students and staff in school settings **are exempt** from the requirement to wear masks, however, individuals should be supported to wear masks if it is their preference to do so.

Masks remain mandatory on public transport. This applies to students aged 12 years and over, and staff when travelling to and from school and during school excursions by public transport or by chartered or private transport services.

Fundraiser

This year we have registered St Joseph's with "Cards that count", a school fundraising initiative that creates professionally printed cards from the students artwork.

Cards that Count is a school fundraising initiative that creates beautiful, professionally printed greeting cards from student artwork.

Each student design is turned into a pack of 10 cards with 10 white envelopes.

The cards are blank inside so they can be used for any occasion.

Student's name, year and school are printed on the back of the card.

The cards are printed in Australia on premium 100% recycled paper.

The card packs are available to order online for \$16 inc GST. Every card pack ordered raises \$5 for your school.

How it works?

Artwork templates on which students create their card designs are sent to your school.

Once completed, the templates are returned to us for processing.

When we have uploaded the artwork, it is available to order for two weeks from our website: www.cardsthatcount.com.au

Ordered card packs are delivered to your school in early November. Funds raised are transferred to your school.

Parent Volunteers

We love parents volunteering at St Joseph's.

All volunteers should sign in at Compass Kiosk in the office on arrival, and sign out when leaving.

When you volunteer for the first time please attend the office to complete a <u>Volunteer Declaration Form</u> and provide ID (drivers licence). You will also be taken through a short induction regarding emergency procedures at St Joseph's.

Compass Parent Portal

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO). Parent guides can be found on the Compass Parent Portal page of our website <u>here</u>.
