#### **Enrichment groups to begin this term**

Our School Improvement Plan (SIP) 2020-2022 goal for teaching and learning is: To develop learners who show initiative, take risks and are proactive in their learning.

As a strategy to meet this goal we had planned to implement some enrichment groups to meet the learning interests of some of our high ability learners. The disruptions to learning in Term 1 & 2 meant we could not plan and put into action this initiative.

So this term we would like to start these groups. A purpose of these groups is to offer children with high ability and high interest in a learning area, an opportunity to work in a small group for 1 hour a week for 4 weeks with a teacher to focus on that area to give them an enriching, engaging experience.

The group will meet for a 1-hour session for 4 weeks for one stage in one subject area. We are beginning with Stage 2 in a writing group with Mrs Paul next week. The next group will be a Stage 3 group working on Literacy and STEM with Mrs McCamey. The groups will be very fluid, dependent on the stage and the subject area. Parents will be informed via email if their child is invited to be part of one of these groups.

#### ICAS assessments - Optional online Maths and English competition exams

You would have received an email on Tuesday with information about these exams. These assessments offer students of higher ability from Years 2-6 an opportunity to complete a challenging exam with higher-order thinking and problem-solving skills in English and Maths.

St Joseph's students have the option of participating in the ICAS Assessments this year. ICAS is developed by UNSW Global, a wholly owned subsidiary of UNSW Sydney.

#### Athletics carnival

Our athletics carnival is tomorrow, Friday 31 July! It looks like the weather will be sunny but cool so make sure children have their jacket packed to wear between their events.

The Google form with details, permission note and registration for events was emailed to all families via Compass last week. There is no cluster carnival to follow on for a school team to represent so we have adjusted our events and processes. Children will compete in running events, long jump, relays and novelty events. We will time the first 2 runners in the track events in case a school record is broken.

Unfortunately, to be able to hold the event we cannot have parents attend as spectators or helpers. We have enough staff to be able to run events and supervise. I request that all parents adhere to this regulation for the health and safety of all.

We will create an iMovie to load on Facebook of all the fun of the day!

All children will come to school and travel by bus to the venue. If you nominated to collect your child by car from the track at Narrabeen please be there by 1.45pm. If you are late, children will be put on the bus at 2pm to return to school.

#### Band Performance assembly- Wednesday 26 August

We will run this as  $3 \times 20$ -minute performances in the Blue room with some classes at each performance and parents can nominate which performance they will attend with a limited number of parents per session. The bands are sounding so good with some great choices of music.

P&F Fundraiser for 2020 - Colour fun run at Narrabeen Oval (Shark Park) - Friday 18 September
 Yesterday Sam Mancell (parent organiser) and I met to discuss some details of this event. There is a
 fundraising component, children collect sponsors to run, and you will receive more details about this part
 next week. This would be our only major fundraising event for the year.

However, the emphasis is on the fun and activity for the kids as they run around the oval through coloured powder stations and enjoy a sausage sizzle lunch.

#### L-E-A-P (Learning Exploring Active Play sessions) Program

This term we are offering the L-E-A-P (Learning Exploring Active Play sessions) program for any families with a child due to commence school in 2021. These sessions are in addition to our more formal kinder 2021 orientation program which will be held in October and November.



Research shows that children who attend play-based sessions during early childhood have significantly better development when they start school, and that the benefits of opportunities such as L.E.A.P are seen across all areas of development as measured by the Australian Early Development Census (AEDC).

Developing large muscles to move, walk, climb and dance; and small muscles to use tools like pencils, scissors, paintbrushes, and playdough.

#### **Compass Parent Portal**

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO).

WHOLE DAY ABSENCE ...... Enter via the APP on your phone (sick, holiday) – you do not need to change the times, the default of "8am to 5pm" covers the school day. Absences of 10 or more days - Request for Leave form must be submitted to the office as well as entering via APP
