### **Teacher's Professional learning**

In the coming weeks I will share with you the School Improvement Plan for 2018.

In the area of **Pastoral Care and Well-being** the staff have begun some professional learning around our Positive Behaviours for Learning (PBL) model. This is part of our school behaviour management policy and the framework we use to teach the children about expected behaviours and to reinforce good behaviours. Pattie Beattie, CSO Education Officer for Pastoral Care and Well-being will be leading us next week focussing on our reward systems. It's always important to affirm and acknowledge when children choose the right behaviours or strive to improve an identified behaviour. We do this at school all the time verbally, often 'on the spot' when the child receives immediate recognition and it has the most benefit. I shall keep you informed and connect you to information about this as we learn.

As you can see it's a busy term (when is it not I can hear you say!). I look forward to seeing you at any of our events and around the playground.
