## Stage 3 leadership camp

#### School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Every school in our Broken Bay Diocese has a 3 year SIP with goals set for 3 years in the areas of Mission, Learning and Teaching, Pastoral Care. The goals are based on the evaluation of the school during the review process conducted every 3 years by the CSO.

Our last school review was 2016 and the goals were formulated at the conclusion of that year for 2017-2019. I'm not sure in all the changes of last year if these goals were shared with the parent community.

Each year there are targets set so that we can measure our success in working towards the goals. We formulate the strategies to meet the goals each year as a school leadership team and all staff are aware of the goals and how our professional learning is planned and purposeful to achieve our SIP goals for the students.

## Kiss N Drop zone - new access to church driveway before school

You may have read in the parish bulletin last weekend that Father Curry is trialling Morning Mass at 7.30 am (instead of 8.30am). This means that the church driveway can now be used as a kiss n drop zone as well as the usual designated drop off zone in Lagoon Street.

If you choose to use this area please note the rules.

- 8.30-9.00 am- Kiss n Drop zone only- DO NOT PARK in the church driveway
- One way set up. Enter from Waterloo St, stay in your car, drop off and exit via Lagoon St.
- Students should not exit cars until your car is at the front of the queue.
- Students walk along the pavement and into the school gate.
- There will be an adult on duty initially to monitor the zone.

**Canteen News-** Due to freezer space and an abundance of choice, the P&F canteen committee has decided to reduce the number of frozen treat choices in the canteen. The Year 6 wellbeing leaders surveyed Years 1-6 students last week and the frozen yoghurts were deemed the least popular. As a result of this decision we will not be purchasing any more frozen yoghurts, once the current stock runs out. Qkr will be updated and a reminder sent out once the current stock is depleted.
