Kinder 2019 Sibling Enrolments

We have now commenced the enrolment process for Kinder 2019. Enrolment packages will be handed out at our Open Morning on Tuesday next week (20 March). Enrolment forms need to be returned to the school office by **31 May 2018**.

If you have a pre-schooler due to start school next year, and happen to miss Open Morning, please see Kerrie in the office to collect an enrolment pack.

Uniform Change Over – Summer/Winter

From the beginning of Term 2, parents can choose on a daily basis whether to send children in Summer or Winter uniform, based on the weather. Uniforms cannot be "mixed and match", it must be either **all Summer**, or **all Winter**.

From **Monday 28 May (week 5, leading into Winter)**, we will change to complete Winter uniform for the remainder of Term 2 and into Term 3.

School Fees
