This week, five of our Year 6 students attended the 'Mathematics Challenge', facilitated by the Australian Mathematics Trust. They will have two follow up sessions, where they work through some extremely complex and challenging problems. These lovely Year 6 students represented our school so well and show tenacity, growth mindset and excellent communication skills, which makes them wonderful ambassadors for St Joseph's.

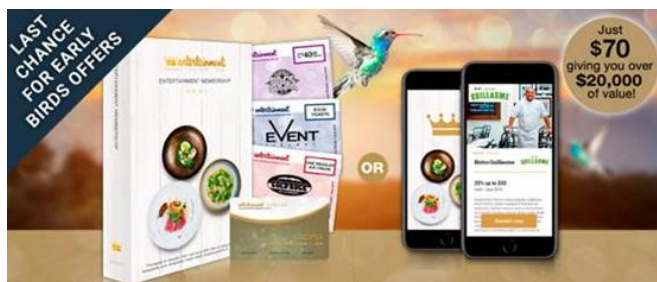

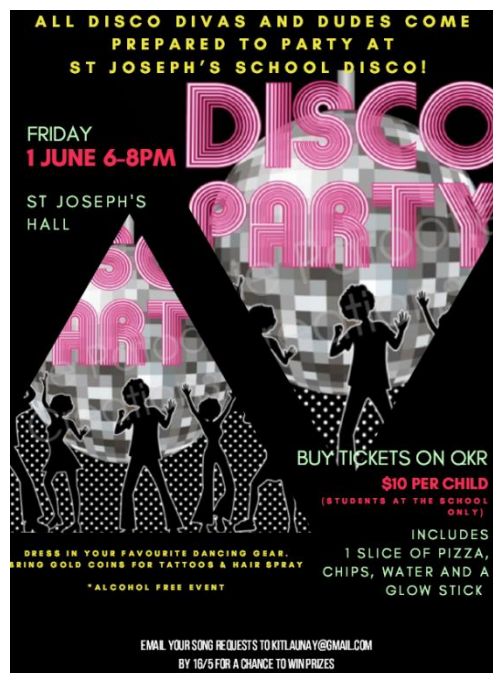
