Fair play on the playground

As part of our teaching in the PDHPE curriculum and through our lessons in PBL (Positive Behaviours for Learning) as well as lessons about SEL (Social and emotional learning), our children are taught social norms as well as school expectations for behaviour in the classroom and playground. The majority of the time and the majority of the children at St Joseph's play well and are inclusive and supportive in their games with others. However, this week I have had to speak with some groups of children about how they are playing games on the playground. There is an attitude of 'win at all costs' that has crept into some games. This means rules are changed or made up that prevent some players to participate fully in a game. Certainly the aim of a game is to win and have fun along the way but it is also about playing the game fairly, giving others a go and not teasing those who get out or gloating excessively when one wins. There are many professional sports people who are exemplary role models of fair play and good sports, win or lose. Sadly, there are also many examples of those who are not.

I ask for your support by talking to your child about what fair play looks and sounds like, pointing out those professionals who are good sports and why. This is timely as well before the Years 3-6 children head off to their respective gala days next week to compete against the other Catholic schools on the Northern Beaches.

Father Rex's final goodbye to us

On Wednesday Father Rex attended morning tea with staff and then the children presented him with a card on which Ciara A from Year 6 had drawn a wonderful portrait of him. Our Year 6 Civics and Citizenship team leaders read a speech thanking Father Rex and then the whole school sang 'This little light of mine' with actions. Word Mania

Some of our classes have been participating in an online word competition on the Literacy Planet site. Year Four have been working hard on it over the past couple of weeks, they are competing against other schools in the Sydney region. They are currently coming first in participation and first in skill, and are also 27^{th} on the ladder against schools from Australia and New Zealand. Mrs Calleja and Year 4 are very excited about participating in the competition next term as there are some great prizes to be won for the school.

Canteen committee

The canteen committee is Mark Page (P&F president), Catherine Strbik, Donita Kerin, Jacqui McKeand and myself. Roles and procedures are becoming more established as the committee works on issues together.

Catherine stocktakes, audits and orders, checking supplies weekly and ordering 'little and often' so that food can be stored and be in date. This may mean that at the end of term certain items will be unavailable, if so, they are temporarily taken off the OKR ordering system.

Donita checks accounts and organises and oversees the roster. She liaises with Kerrie in the office to close off OKR if there are not enough volunteers for a particular day. We are looking into using an App for the roster. Jacqui is currently away but will update manuals, procedures and train anyone who would like to begin volunteering in the canteen.



Athletics Carnival – Friday 3 August

An email was sent home on Monday this week with details and Google Form link for our 2018 Athletics Carnival which will be held at the Academy of Sport, Narrabeen. Please complete your entry by Friday 6 July (last day of Term 2).



ALL children will be required to travel to the venue by bus with the whole school. The bus will leave school at **9.05am** and return at **2.50pm**. Should you wish to take your child home at the conclusion of the carnival (expected time is 2 pm) please indicate on the Google form (link below).

The carnival will run simultaneously as an **INFANTS SKILL DEVELOPMENT CARNIVAL for KINDERGARTEN and YEAR 1** on the grass area in the middle of the track (this includes modified field events, novelty races, relay and running races) and a **PRIMARY CARNIVAL for YEARS 2-6**.

5, 6, 7 YEAR OLDS - They are eligible to compete in the track in the 70m and 100m **ALL AGES** - 100m - these are run in age groups and separate boys and girls

ALL OTHER EVENTS

800m - this event is run as a timed final Junior (under 8,9 and 10's); 11 years and 12 Years 200m - this event is run as a timed final Junior (under 8,9 and 10's); 11 years and 12 Years

FIELD EVENTS - Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Put and Discus - please note all field events are grouped into Junior (under 8.9 and 10's); 11 years and 12 Years

UNIFORM - Students must wear their sports uniform including a hat and their colour house t-shirt. Please remember to bring recess, lunch, drinks for the day, sunscreen and any required medication

PARENT HELPERS - As always, without our PARENTS we could not run a carnival. If you can spare anytime on the day please indicate on the Google Form.
