


Grandparents Mass & Morning Tea

School Fees

Standard Instalments: Second payment was due 4 May, final payment due 27 July

Monthly Instalments: Payments are due on the 15th of each month, **15 July through to November**

Fortnightly Instalments: Payments due 13, 27 Jul, 10, 24 Aug, 7, 21 Sept, 5, 19 Oct, 2 Nov
