NAPLAN results- Years 3 & 5

We received the report letters for parents on Monday and they were sent home in students bags on Tuesday. Usually schools are also given access to an online assessment reporting tool which enables us to look carefully at the results and compare trends and growth in learning. However, this year NESA has phased in access to this site and we have not been given access as yet. This means we are unable to analyse results in the usual way at the moment.

The following quote is a reminder that NAPLAN is one source of assessment we use.

"NAPLAN gives a snapshot of your child's performance on the days of the assessments and the results should be interpreted with care. There are many reasons why students' results may vary. Some students may perform much better than expected when compared against their regular classroom assessment results, while other students may not perform as well as expected."

Feast Day of St Francis.

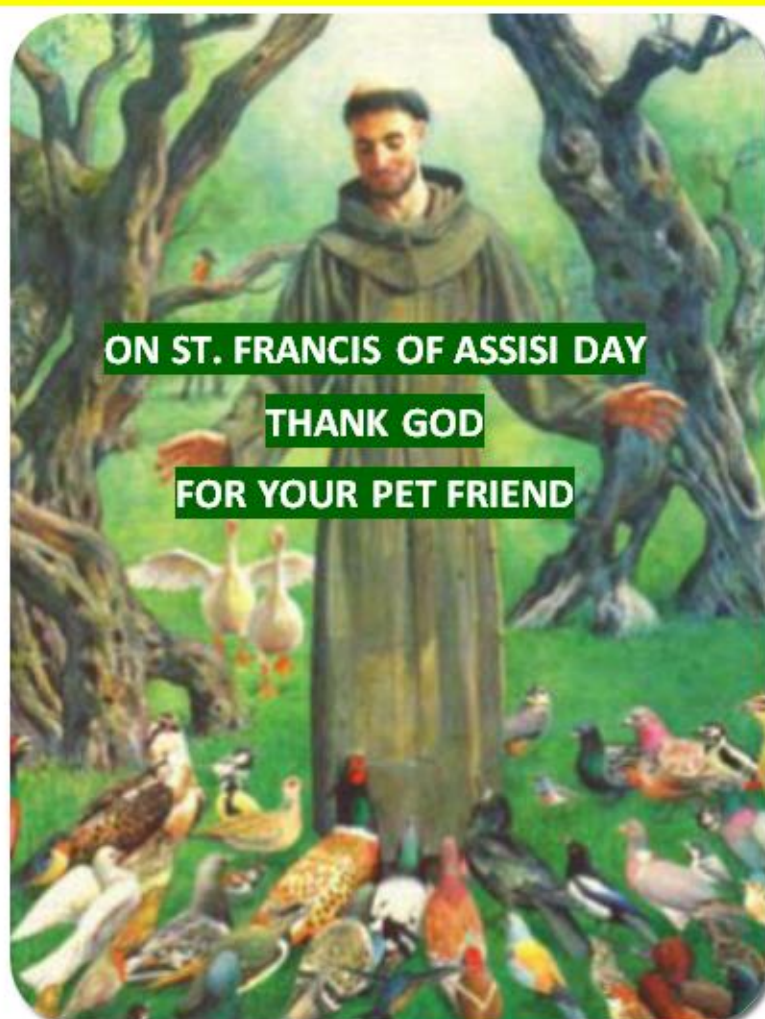

Leaving School Early / Absence / Holidays
