Kinder 2019 Sibling Enrolments

We have now commenced the enrolment process for Kinder 2019. Enrolment forms need to be returned to the school office by 31 May 2018. If you have a pre-schooler due to start school next year, and missed Open Morning, please see Kerrie in the office to collect an enrolment pack.

Uniform Change Over – Summer/Winter

From the beginning of Term 2, parents can choose on a daily basis whether to send children in Summer or Winter uniform, based on the weather. Uniforms cannot be "mixed and matched", they must be either all Summer, or all Winter. From Monday 28 May (week 5, leading into Winter), we will change to complete Winter uniform for the remainder of Term 2 and into Term 3.

Payments are due on the 15th of each month. Monthly Instalments: Fortnightly Instalments: Payments due 6, 20 April and 4, 18 May


