Dear Parents

Our welcome to new parents evening last Friday night was a lovely casual evening getting to know new families. Open Day

Uniform @ Lowes

I have received numerous emails and messages from parents about the lack of sports shirts and boys summer shirts in stock at Lowes. I have met with the sales rep who has assured me that stock has been ordered and will be in the store by the end of March. I have expressed my concern that there should have been adequate stock in January and been assured that this will be remedied. This was part of the message I received:

I sincerely apologise for the frustrations this has brought onto your school community. I would like to assure you I am doing all I can to get this new stock to our Warriewood store as fast as I can. According to our sales for back to school, we sold 82 in total of the layback shirts and 75 in total of the sports polo.

Meanwhile the 'old' school jacket, with front zip and fleece inside has been put on special for \$10 (see flyer at back of newsletter). This jacket can be purchased and worn, maybe as a spare or if your child is needing one for just one or two years more. The new style polar fleece jacket has been ordered and will be in store soon. I will continue to email and meet with the rep about our concerns so that Lowes meet their contractual requirements as our uniform supplier.

School Band

If your child was in school band last year or completed an interest form to join the school band this year you would have been contacted via email by Monique Warokka, the new band provider, about her program, fees and days.

If you have not responded to her email could you please respond either way? If you didn't receive the email please contact the office so we can pass on your email.

The school band is an extra- curricular activity that we are very happy to offer and support as we know the benefits that playing an instrument brings to children. However, it is run as a business by the outside providers. The band cannot start unless there are enough students to make this viable.

Our clean-up has been organised by the Year 6 Environment leadership team and their mentor teacher, Mrs Kath Fogwell. We will all be doing our bit to clean up our beautiful part of the world.

The environment team has advised that the gloves that have been sent to school may be too small for years 5&6 who can bring along their own pair from home.


Safety on internet and social media- for parents!



Messages from the office
