St Joseph's Athletics Carnival Expectations

- All children are to remain in their colour house area and cheer for their teams when not competing.
- Listen for your race to be called and go straight to the marshalling area.
- Ask a teacher's permission to go to the toilet and go with a buddy.
- Ask your colour house captain or teacher in charge for help if you need it.
- Be sun safe- wear a hat.
- Remember to apply and re-apply sunscreen.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Keep your colour house area neat and tidy.
- Remember to be safe, respectful, learners at all times.
- Canteen is OUT OF BOUNDS.
- Behind grandstand and side of grandstand OUT OF BOUNDS.

Ribbons

Championship events will be timed and ribbons will be handed out for 1^{st} to 3^{rd} place. 1^{st} to 3^{rd} place will be given a marker, and they will need to go to the recording table to receive their ribbon.

Colour house points

House points will be awarded in events depending on the place (5, 3, 2 points). House points will also be awarded for the Spirit trophy for cheering and clean house areas.

Representative team

Students will be chosen from championship events to represent St Josephs at the Northern Beaches Catholic Schools Athletics Carnival at Sydney Academy of Sport, Narrabeen. Three students per age (8-12) are chosen for 100m. For other events, two students are chosen for the Junior (8, 9, 10), 11yrs & 12 yrs age groups. The representative team will be announced at school, and notes will be distributed.

End of Carnival Procedure

- All children are to stay and support their team until the end of the carnival.
- Every one must help with cleaning up before leaving.
- If you are going home with your parents, you need your name marked off with your class teacher.
- If you are going home with another parent, you need your name marked off with your class teacher.
- Remain in your colour house area with your supervising teacher if you are going back to school on the bus.
