

Kindergarten Home Based Learning Week 10 Tasks

*Please follow the suggested daily timetable for the structure and pace of activities throughout your week.

<p>English: Writing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose 4 toys at home. Draw a picture of each on 1 page in your HBL book and write the letter for the beginning sound of each.• Have a go at writing a sentence starting “I am..” in your book and draw a picture. An adult can help you write the rest of the sentence.	<p>Maths: Friends of 10: Choose 10 small objects (counters/cars/toys etc). Try to find all the different pairs of numbers that add up to 10 using the objects. Eg. $6 + 4 = 10$. Draw and write in your HBL book.</p> <p>Position: Watch Rosie’s Walk story https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R3kNUTwJhf8</p> <p>Choose somewhere to sit at home. In your HBL book draw 3 things in front of you & 3 things behind you. Ask an adult to label the drawings.</p> <p><i>Use position words to give someone directions to get from place to another/find an object in your home. Eg. Forwards, left, right, turn, look up, look down, in front of, behind, at the side, next to etc. Ask someone to direct you to follow directions. You could create a treasure hunt using position words!</i></p>	<p>Creative Arts/PE “Art Hub for Kids” on youtube has step by step instructions for a range of pictures. Draw a picture of it. Ask an adult to help write how it moves or label the parts. Complete the Seesaw Push and Pull sorting activity.</p>	<p>See Saw I have set some great tasks on SeeSaw for you too. Including Maths and English.</p> <p>Your child will need to log on using their own code which has been supplied to you on the front of your homebased learning book.</p>
