*Please follow the suggested daily timetable for the structure and pace of activities throughout your week.

<p>English:</p> <p>Writing <u>Learning Intentions:</u> <i>*I can write a sentence.</i> <i>*I can hear, segment (break up) & write the sounds in some cvc words.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● News writing: Choose an activity you enjoyed in the school holidays. Draw a picture and have a go at writing a sentence. <i>Remember...spaces between words. Capital letter for the 1st word, full stop at the end. You could use your Humpty wordwall to find keywords and have a go at the beginning sounds for other words.</i>● CVC Words. Try to spell some simple consonant-vowel consonant words by sounding them out eg. hat, pan, sit, fin, can, hot . Perhaps you can think of and write some words that rhyme eg. man, can, fan, tan...Write them in your HBL book.	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Number : <u>Learning Intentions:</u> <i>*I can count forwards and backwards.</i> <i>*I can write numbers to at least 20.</i> <i>*I can recognise groups of 2.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Practise counting forwards and backwards out-loud from any number up to 20/50/100/● Write as many numbers as you can in order starting from 0.● Counting in 2s: Watch this song: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8wwydgU5KOU● Organise some toys/objects into pairs and draw and label or take a photo for Seesaw. <p>3D Shape <i>L:I: I can recognise and describe 3D objects</i> Have a go at drawing these 3D shapes in your HBL book; Cube, rectangular prism, sphere. Pyramid. Perhaps you can use some lego/playdough/plasticine etc to make some models and upload a photo or video on Seesaw.</p>	<p>Creative Arts</p> <p>Make an Autumn artwork/craft. 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<p>Religion</p> <p>The Bible: Introducing God's Story</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read or watch the story of Moses in the Basket from the old Testament. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=vf-4x4iefQE Draw a picture from the story and try to write a sentence or have a go at making a model or craft of the baby Moses in the basket floating down the river. 	<p>History/Science</p> <p>Science: Seasons What season are we in now? How do you know? Take a look outside and notice some signs. You could take some photos for Seesaw.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find an item of clothing at home that you might wear in each season: Spring/Summer/Autumn/Winter. Draw and label in your HBL book or take a photo (you might want to dress up!) and upload on Seesaw. <p>History: What stories do people tell about the past?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask a parent/grandparent/auntie/uncle to tell you a story about when they were young. You could face-time/skype/zoom call them if they don't live at your home! 	<p>See Saw</p> <p>I have set some great tasks on SeeSaw for you too including Maths and English.</p> <p>Your child will need to log on using their own code which has been supplied to you on the front of your homebased learning book.</p>
