Staggered return to school from Monday 11 May - Week 3

As communicated here last week and again in an email to all families on Friday afternoon, the staggered return to school will begin on Monday 11 May. Students will be attending according to their colour house.

Monday- Green (Aloysius) Tuesday- Blue (Polding) Wednesday- Red (St Joseph's) Thursday- Yellow (Therry)

This plan enables families to attend on the same day and for an equal amount of children to be on the premises each day.

The government's intent with the staggered return is to 'test the waters' in terms of the safety and health of the students, teachers and families. Therefore, we will monitor and evaluate day by day week by week how our plan works, at the same time adhering to the regulations asked of us by the CSO and government. We will notify you if plans have to change at short notice.

On your child's allocated day they will have face to face teaching time with their class teacher in the areas of English and Maths. If your child needs to attend school on other days that are not their allocated day due to your work requirements, they will continue to be supervised by teachers on a roster system to continue their HBL in the library or another space. This means that teachers will not be on call online as much because they will be in the classroom working with children as well as trying to check the See Saw or Google classroom. Please be patient if you or your child does not receive a reply immediately.

From next week, teachers will plan work online for 4 days for students to continue at home. We are very much looking forward to seeing the students in person next week.

Keeping safe and well at school

Please adhere to the government regulations and DO NOT send your child to school if they are unwell. If we can all keep healthy then it's more likely we can move quickly to full time school for everyone. Teachers will practice physical distancing with each other and parents as much as we can. We ask that when dropping off or picking up your child you also keep physical distance outside and inside the playground and keep the footpath clear. From Monday there will be a hygienist at every Diocesan school to sanitize and wipe down high use surfaces during the day. There are bottles of hand sanitiser in every room, please let us know if your child is not able to use this. We are asking children to hand wash before and after food breaks. We will be opening windows and doors for cross ventilation and this may make the rooms colder. See uniform advice below.

The canteen will not be open until further notice from the CSO.

Uniform

At this time children can wear summer or winter uniform according to the weather. Children will be required to be in full winter uniform by week 4 (18 May). When children come for one day a week, they can wear their sports uniform for comfort. Please pack your child's jacket as the rooms will be a little colder.

Re school bus services delivered by State Transit during COVID-19

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is working closely with the Department of Education to ensure school students across the state get back to the classroom safely.

At State Transit we are proudly playing our role in making the return to face-to-face learning happen. This is one of the ways our people and our buses are continuing to support the community during the Coronavirus outbreak.

Parents and carers should make travel choices that suit their individual needs and circumstances but please know we are here to support them.

TfNSW continues to provide full public transport services across all modes during COVID-19 to enable essential travel, which includes State Transit's buses.

Cleaning across the entire transport network has been ramped up to protect our customers and our people. State Transit's entire bus fleet is sanitised every day, with a focus on high-touch areas like handrails, stop buttons and Opal readers.

We continue to promote and encourage social distancing, however this may not be possible at all times on buses carrying school students as we will not allow school children to be left at bus stops.

Please encourage students travelling with us to tap on and tap off with their Opal card, which helps us better understand travel patterns and service capacity.

We will continue to work with schools and monitor school services over the coming weeks.

The safety of your students and our bus drivers is my top priority. If you have any concerns during this time please contact your local State Transit depot.

KEEP UP KIDS' CRUNCH&SIP BREAK

The Crunch&Sip break is a great routine to keep up at home-school.

When you volunteer for the first time please attend the office to complete a <u>Volunteer Declaration Form</u> and provide ID (drivers licence). You will also be taken through a short induction regarding emergency procedures at St Joseph's.

Compass Parent Portal

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO).

WHOLE DAY ABSENCE Enter via the APP on your phone (sick, holiday) – you do not need to change the times, the default of "8am to 5pm" covers the school day. Absences of 10 or more days - <u>Request for Leave</u> form must be submitted to the office as well as entering via APP
