Congratulations to stage 3 for their deep understanding and application to designing a toy or game using a basic electrical circuit. In stage 1 (year 1&2) the students completed their history unit about life in the past by bringing in a stick (did you know the humble stick was entered into the toy hall of fame?) to create a game and then demonstrate to their peers. Year 4 success in the Term 2 'Story-a-thon 100 word' story competition

Once again this term, we had finalists and a student in the top 10 for the Storyathon "A Different World - Living in Lockdown" Term 2 story writing competition. Students created over 20,000 stories online across Australia. The Storyathon people reported:

It has provided tremendous insight into how children across various ages and locations have responded to the incredibly challenging times. The insights have received considerable media attention.

The wonderful thing about this competition is that all students vote online for the most popular stories. Teachers are asked not to intervene with editing.

This term our Finalists were Isaac C, Ciara Q and Erin L. Isaac C was awarded in the Top 10 for the Year 3 and 4 (middle primary) category. Congratulations to these talented writers!

Semester 1 reports and parent/ teacher interviews

As notified previously, Semester 1 reports will be available via Compass tomorrow, Friday 3 July. Due to the interruptions to face to face learning over the semester the report is a modified form of our usual report. The report cover will have this explanation:

This report provides you with information about your child's learning during Semester 1, 2020. It reflects that learning during Semester 1, 2020 has been both school-based and home-based due to COVID-19. During Term 2 the priority for learning has been Religious Education, English and Mathematics. This report provides information on your child's achievement in these priority areas. The school will organise opportunities for you to discuss your child's progress.

Reports can be accessed from the Compass Parent Portal. On the App, select your child, then the "Reports" tab and you will see "Semester 1 2020".

Parent teacher interviews will be available in the first 2 weeks of Term 3

Booking for interviews are also via the Compass app. Thank you to those parents who have already booked their time. Please log on and book your time slot with your class teacher.

This year we are inviting you to have a '3-way interview'. This means the parent, teacher AND student are present at the interview to discuss progression of learning and future goals. This offer is open to parents of students in years 2-6. This acknowledges the fact that students are active engaged participants in their learning who can articulate their areas of strength, improvement and difficulty. It means learning is not something that happens TO them but something they participate in and make decisions about at a certain level too. The 3-way interview is an option.

Canteen opening next term

As notified this week, canteen will reopen on Friday 24 July and then every Monday and Friday next term if we have enough volunteers. Canteen will only be open for lunch orders, no morning tea over the counter service.

Returning to Mass

Next term classes will start to return to Mass with the parish at 9:30am Mass on Thursdays. This can be done up to 30 minutes before Mass, and all members of the same household may sit together when attending Mass.

Compass – Parent Teacher Interview Bookings

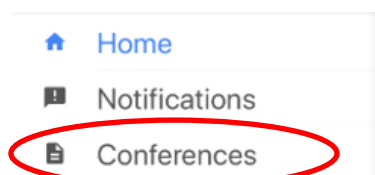
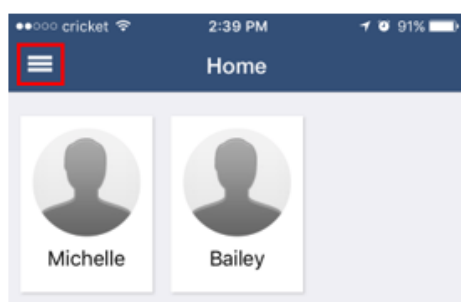
BOOKINGS ARE CURRENTLY OPEN

Booking your Parent/Teacher Interview (called “Conferences” on Compass)

- On the Compass APP on your phone, click the three horizontal bars in the top left corner and then select 'Conferences' from the menu that slides open. The main Conference screen will open where you can see all Conference cycles (interviews) that the school has made available to parents. To start the booking process click on **“2020 Parent Teacher Interviews”**.
- A message will pop up with details of the conference cycle you have selected. Once read, click “okay” at the bottom to continue.
- If you have more than one child, you will need to select which student to book for first. Select one of your students to proceed with booking. If you have only one child at St Joseph’s, you will not see this screen.
- A summary of the teacher you can book with for the student you select will be displayed. To book in, click your child’s teacher’s name.
- The next screen will show the available timeslots for this teacher. Select a timeslot.
- Once you select “Confirm Booking” you will see a summary of your bookings showing staff member, student name, time and date.
- If you need to change your booking, you can go back in and remove your booking and choose a different timeslot.
- Once bookings have closed (end of term), you will not be able to change your booking.



Interview bookings can be made in the Compass parent portal (either on your phone or on a web browser on PC/laptop).

Instructions for accessing Compass on either a web browser or the App can be found on our school website [here](#). If you require assistance setting up the Compass app on your phone, please phone Kerrie in the office who can talk you through the steps.

Handy Hints

- When searching for our school to set up initially, search “Narrabeen”, not “St Josephs”.*
- Do not “log out” when you have finished using the App on your phone, just close the App (saves having to remember your login details).*

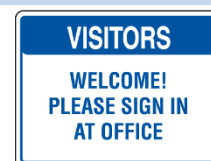

Parent Volunteers

When you volunteer for the first time please attend the office to complete a [Volunteer Declaration Form](#) and provide ID (drivers licence). You will also be taken through a short induction regarding emergency procedures at St Joseph's.



Compass Parent Portal

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO).

WHOLE DAY ABSENCE Enter via the APP on your phone (sick, holiday) – you do not need to change the times, the default of “8am to 5pm” covers the school day. Absences of 10 or more days - [Request for Leave](#) form must be submitted to the office as well as entering via APP

ARRIVING TO SCHOOL LATE .. Enter via Kiosk in school office
