By now you have received the information pack about this afternoon of FUN and fundraising.

Sam Mancell has been posting details of how to register online on the class FB pages. Hopefully we will have fine weather for another fun outside event for the kids. Sam is organising some parent helpers for roles and all teachers will be in attendance. **Unfortunately, we cannot have parent spectators as per Covid safe requirements** by Catholic schools NSW and NB Council. We will have some live streaming on the FB page as we did for the Athletics Carnival.

### Uniform

This week we have asked the children to pay attention to wearing the correct uniform on the right day. As all classes are participating in basketball clinics for the next 4 weeks on a Thursday, sport uniform is only to be worn on Thursdays and Fridays.

Photo day on Wednesday indicated to us that all children have the correct uniform including a tie for the boys, collar tab for the girls and correct socks or stockings. Children in incorrect uniform will be given a verbal prompting to have the correct uniform the next day and then a note to go home if consistently wearing the uniform incorrectly. As per our policy in the parent handbook:

- *SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY - All students are expected to be dressed in the correct school uniform. Summer uniforms are worn in Term 1 and Term 4. Winter uniforms are worn in Term 2 and Term 3. Parents will be advised in extreme out of season weather which uniform may be worn.*

- *DRESS EXPECTATIONS - Always tidy, shoes cleaned at least once weekly and winter ties on properly. Black school shoes for our everyday uniform and white sandshoes for Sports Day.*
- *HAIR – Girls: long hair should be tied back. Hair ribbons must be in the school colours (blue/white). Boys: neat, not too long, no chemical colouring or extreme hairstyles.*
- *JEWELLERY - Girls only are permitted to wear sleepers or stud earrings to school. No nail polish, bracelets, rings, necklaces etc.*
- *HATS - All children must wear the school hat for outdoor play.*

### Term 3 events

As stated in my last newsletter, the changing regulations for what we can and can't do has meant a change in our normal calendar of events.

This week, with directive from our CSO we have had to make the decision to **cancel the Year 5&6 overnight camp to Bathurst scheduled for 5-6 November**. The risks involved were greater than the safety measures we could put in place. I told the Year 5&6 students today and although obviously disappointed we pointed out that they were lucky to have their leadership camp back in early March before Covid restrictions.

As stated last week, **Northern Beaches Catholic schools Gala Days for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 scheduled for week 9 later in the term have been cancelled** as Covid regulations could not be met and guaranteed.

**Band Performance assembly- Wednesday 26 August** - We will run this as 3 x 20-minute performances in the Blue Room with some classes at each performance and parents can nominate which performance they will attend with a limited number of parents per session. The bands are sounding so good with some great choices of music.

**P&F meeting** - The Term 3 meeting is set for **Monday 31 August via Zoom @ 7pm**. Please join us to hear about school initiatives and events. In what has been a year when it has been hard to connect as a community this is an opportunity to see some familiar faces and listen to school happenings.

### Fee relief

The CSO has advised that Fee Relief will continue into 2021 for those families still affected by change in work circumstances at that time. Details of application will be made available in the new year when fee statements go home.

# L-E-A-P (Learning Exploring Active Play sessions) Program

This term we are offering the L-E-A-P (Learning Exploring Active Play sessions) program for any families with a child due to commence school in 2021. These sessions are in addition to our more formal kinder 2021 orientation program which will be held in October and November.



Research shows that children who attend play-based sessions during early childhood have significantly better development when they start school, and that the benefits of opportunities such as L.E.A.P are seen across all areas of development as measured by the Australian Early Development Census (AEDC).

### Feast of the Assumption

This Saturday 15 August, we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption. The Christian feast day of the Assumption of Mary celebrates the belief that God assumed the Virgin Mary into Heaven following her death.

This year it is not a Holy day of obligation.

Next Thursday 20 August, Year 2 and Year 3 will be holding a small liturgy in the church at 2:40pm where they will celebrate the life of Mary. Father Robert is happy for parents to join us for this liturgy. The church has much stricter guidelines regarding Covid and we all must socially distance however families from the same household are allowed to sit together.



# National Science Week

### Parent Volunteers

All volunteers should sign in at Compass Kiosk in the office on arrival, and sign out when leaving.

When you volunteer for the first time please attend the office to complete a [Volunteer Declaration Form](#) and provide ID (drivers licence). You will also be taken through a short induction regarding emergency procedures at St Joseph's.



### Compass Parent Portal

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO).

**WHOLE DAY ABSENCE** ..... Enter via the APP on your phone (sick, holiday) – you do not need to change the times, the default of “8am to 5pm” covers the school day. Absences of 10 or more days - [Request for Leave](#) form must be submitted to the office as well as entering via APP

**ARRIVING TO SCHOOL LATE** .. Enter via Kiosk in school office
