### **Dear Parents**

This week you would have heard in the media that the NSW Dept of Health has introduced some new Covid 19 related restrictions for schools. Yesterday, we received a directive from our CSO who take direction from the NSW peak body for Catholic systemic schools - CSNSW, re: new restrictions in place effective Friday 20 August.

Although a lot of the directives about graduation events and interschool sporting events apply to the high schools there are still many that affect us.

Please read these carefully.

- 1. Staff and students who suspect they may have COVID-19 **must not return to school** or work until they return a negative COVID-19 result and are symptom-free. Schools **must sight the negative COVID-19 test result**.
- 2. We now require that you screenshot your negative result and email to the office.
- 3. From tomorrow, Friday 20 August we are restricting parents from entering the school unless they are visiting the office for admin business or to check in a child late or check out a child early. This means that morning drop off and afternoon pick up will be different.
  - In the morning we ask that you drop your child at the gate, no parents to enter the playground please.
  - In the afternoon we encourage you to access the kiss n ride pick up zone in your car OR if picking up by foot you may enter the school ground BUT ONLY STAND ON THE BASKETBALL COURT 1.5M from other parents.
  - Kinder and Year 1 children and their siblings will be dismissed at 3pm, other grades at 3.05 pm.
  - Please collect your child and leave promptly. We believe allowing parents to wait on the court allows for social distancing better than on the pavement outside. Please DO NOT WAIT OUTSIDE YOUR CHILD'S ROOM.
  - I know this is not conducive to building community but hopefully these stricter measures will only be for the remainder of this term.
- 4. To limit adults in the school, *only external providers* **essential to the delivery of curriculum** may continue. What this means is that music tuition, band and drama cannot continue at school. The providers of both those activities will contact you.
- 5. The band will still perform at assembly outside next Wednesday as they have been rehearsing for this performance for a few weeks and we look forward to enjoying this performance. If you are a band parent you must register with Monique for what time performance you will attend so that we limit numbers of parents at each session.

### P&F Fundraiser for 2020. Run4Fun Colour Explosion run at Narrabeen Oval. (Shark Park) Friday 18 September from 12pm

Fortunately, this event still meets the current Covid 19 criteria and restrictions. The children will walk to Shark Park at 11.30am ready for a 12pm start. The children will sit in their class groups and run with their class, being showered with coloured powder along the way. They will enjoy a sausage sizzle afterwards. The afternoon will be complete by 2.30pm.

Parents may nominate to pick up their child from the park or staff will walk children back to school for buses and After School Care by 3pm.

To meet the safety criteria for this event there is unfortunately strictly NO PARENT SPECTATORS. There will be some parent helpers who will wear a high vis vest and have a clear role on the day with appropriate paperwork filled out as per the Covid safety plan. Sam Mancell is contacting some class parents to be helpers.

Today we are providing information about the actual colour powder used in the run. The <u>linked form</u> has the details and a section to complete ONLY IF YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD TO HAVE THE POWDER used on them.

You can contact Sam Mancell if you would like more details. There is also a copy linked to the class FB pages.

In two weeks, there will be a Google permission note for parents to complete giving permission for walking to Shark Park and nominating if you would like to pick up your child from there at 2.30pm.

### Uniform

We have noted an improvement this week in wearing correct uniform. Thank you parents for supporting us on this. A reminder that all classes are participating in basketball clinics for the next four weeks on a Thursday, therefore sport uniform is only to be worn on Thursdays and Fridays.

• **Band Performance assembly- Wednesday 26 August -** This will happen outside under the shade cloth in three performance times. 2pm, 2.20pm & 2.40 pm.

Classes will come out in three different groups to enjoy the performance. If you are a band parent you may attend but as stated above, must nominate to Monique which performance you will attend. The bands are sounding so good with some great choices of music.

• **P&F meeting** - The Term 3 meeting is set for Monday 31 August via Zoom @ 7pm. Please join us to hear about school initiatives and events. In what has been a year when it has been hard to connect as a community this is an opportunity to see some familiar faces and listen to school happenings.

### **Parent Volunteers**

We love parents volunteering at St Joseph's.

All volunteers should sign in at Compass Kiosk in the office on arrival, and sign out when leaving.

When you volunteer for the first time please attend the office to complete a <u>Volunteer Declaration Form</u> and provide ID (drivers licence). You will also be taken through a short induction regarding emergency procedures at St Joseph's.

#### **Compass Parent Portal**

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO).

WHOLE DAY ABSENCE ............ Enter via the APP on your phone (sick, holiday) – you do not need to change the times, the default of "8am to 5pm" covers the school day. Absences of 10 or more days - <u>Request for Leave</u> form must be submitted to the office as well as entering via APP
