Welcome to Catholic Schools Broken Bay's Culture Survey

As an important member of our Catholic Schools Broken Bay community, we would like to invite you to take part in a survey that will help shape the culture of your child's school.

This initiative is part of a broader strategy called Towards 2025 which aims to make our schools amongst the best in Australia and to ensure that all the students in our care can be the best they can be.

We recognise that our schools, and the community that supports them, always need to keep improving. To achieve our vision of consistently providing an authentic, professional Catholic education with care and compassion, we are exploring new ways of working and new ways of supporting our students.

As well as selected parents/carers and students, all school and office staff and clergy are being invited to participate in the survey, so we have a comprehensive view of our collective culture.

The survey will identify and check the alignment between our personal values, the values/behaviours currently experienced, and the values that you believe are most important for the development of our school system. There are no right or wrong answers.

Conducted by external experts Peak Performance International, the survey is anonymous, and the results will be aggregated and analysed. It takes about 10-15 minutes to finish and needs to be completed in one sitting. We also suggest you complete the survey on a laptop or tablet screen rather than a small mobile screen.

The survey will be open from today until **14 May** and we ask that you complete it as soon as possible whilst it is fresh in your mind.

Following the survey, several focus groups will be held to explore the major themes that emerge. Upon completion, the final results will be compiled, and I look forward to communicating them to our school community during term 3
