Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Given the ongoing cases of community transmission and following updated health advice, the NSW Government has announced today that the current lockdown will be extended for another week until Friday, 16 July.

This decision affects all Catholic schools in Broken Bay.

As a result, your child will be involved in home-based learning from Tuesday, 13 July. **Schools will remain open for students who need to attend and no child will be turned away from school.**

No formal teaching will take place on Monday as teachers will meet and prepare for home-based learning. Home based learning will be provided from Tuesday to Friday next week. In order to minimise the risk of spreading COVID, no parent is allowed on site, unless it is essential, for example to collect IT equipment or other materials.

Year 12 students are allowed on site if required. Your school will provide further information in this regard.

We are mindful of the impact that this extended lockdown may have on some families and its impact on their ability to pay school fees.
