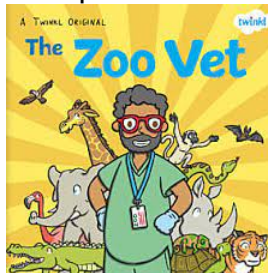

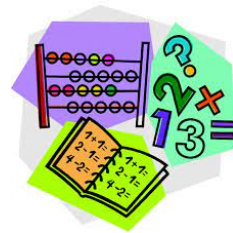

Think of at least 7 different animals that could be at the zoo and write a list.

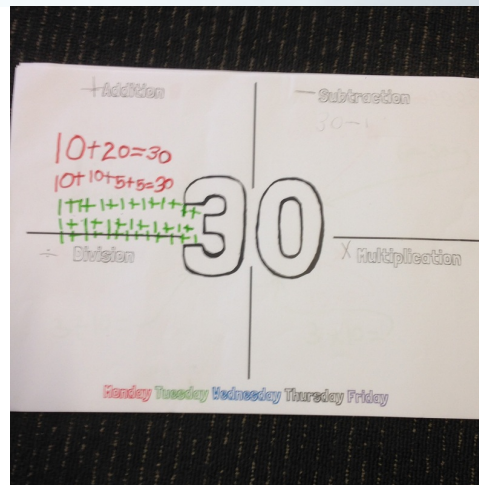
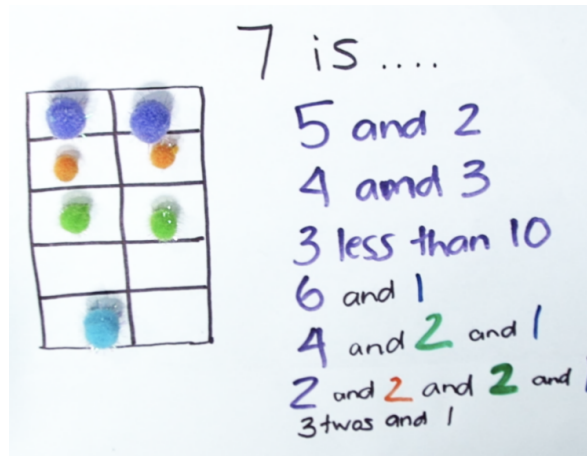
Challenge: Write some verbs (action words) to describe how each animal could move eg. Kangaroo - jump

Use the worksheet to put the coins in order from smallest to largest

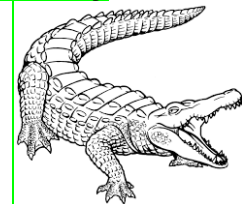
Challenge: Choose the "Ordering Coins and Notes" worksheet instead.

Challenge: Use a non-standard unit of measurement (cubes/counters/lego/pasta etc) to measure each crocodile.

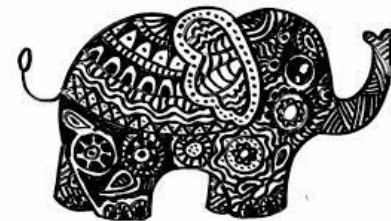
Visual Arts/Fine-Motor Skills

Friday: Length Investigation - Measuring Me!



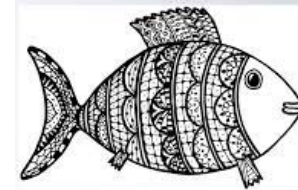
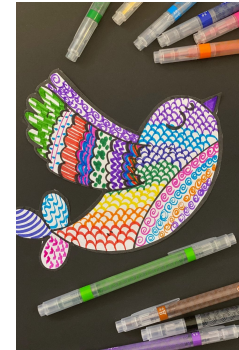
Use some string/make paper streamers to measure different body parts and compare the lengths of objects around your home. Draw/write your findings or take photos and post on Seesaw.
