Please take the time to click on the link and read the information as there are changes due to meeting the government regulations for return to school.

Parents cannot enter the school for drop off or pick up. We know some of the children may be nervous or shy about returning. The teacher on playground duty is aware and will look out to see if you need help at the gate.

Pick up in the afternoons will look different too. We have made plans to relieve some congestion at the gates at that time.

If you have children in JUST kinder to year 2 you can pick up at 2.50pm at either kiss n ride or in person at the Lagoon St pedestrian gate. Those children being picked up in person, will be lined up at the gate in single file and we ask that parents line up in single file on the street, starting at the gate then down towards the church. Say your child's name to the teacher and they will be brought to the gate.

Thank you to the parents this week who have been patient and worked with us to make this new dismissal process work. Could you please inform your child how you will pick them up, by car or walking so we know which line to put them on. This will help us enormously.


Catching up with learning

All teachers are spending time this week assessing where kids are at in the key learning areas of English and Maths. We are allocating days to teachers in the next two weeks to be able to withdraw children and do some quick one on one reading and maths assessments, so we know exactly where to plan and target our teaching. We spent our professional learning meeting yesterday afternoon planning this process.

Teachers and staff will be wearing masks both inside and out until such time the government changes the rules for schools.

Assessment bookings will be via the Compass Parent Portal. Students attend only for their booked time slot. Parents will be advised once bookings open in December.

School Buses – Student Opal Card

Message from Transport NSW – School Bus Opal Cards

Applications for student travel in 2022 opened on **Tuesday 12 October 2021**. Students who need a School Opal card or travel pass for 2022 can <u>apply</u> now. A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for a school travel pass for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (eg joint custody).

Students who change address, school, campus location, or who have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should <u>renew or update</u> their details before **the end of term 4**. This will ensure that schools can endorse applications and current entitlements are updated and remain valid. School Opal card holders will have the changes applied to their existing card.

If a student's distance eligibility has changed based on their grade the system will automatically update their entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new <u>eligibility criteria</u>, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students in the Opal network applying for an Opal card (including a Term Bus Pass) for the first time will receive their Student Opal card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2022.

We ask that parents plan ahead and make sure their child knows which service/s to use and has a valid ticket to travel; either a School Opal card or Child/Youth Opal card (within Greater Sydney) or a School Travel Pass (outside Greater Sydney), from the start of the school year.

Compass Parent Portal

There are two ways to access Compass - using the parent portal on any modern web browser or using the 'Compass School Manager' app on your mobile device. Parents can enter full day absences, access student academic reports, school calendar and update contact numbers and email addresses via Compass. All parents have their own individual login details (emailed direct to you from the CSO). Parent guides can be found on the Compass Parent Portal page of our website <u>here</u>.
