Curriculum Information for Term 2 2022 for Kindergarten

Dear Parents.

Welcome back to Term 2. We are all very excited for another term of learning. In the interests of parent engagement, and the hopes that you will ask your child about their learning, this is a quick and simple guide to what your child is focusing on this term in Kindergarten.

This term we will have two student teachers from ACU joining us throughout the term. We welcome Mr Rogan and Mr Hammill to Kindergarten.



During Term 2 we are continuing our new CSBB Early Stage 1 **Religious Education** curriculum using play-based principles and resources. This program includes the ceremony of Baptism as well as symbols found in church.

This term in **English** the main areas of learning include recognising initial, middle and final sounds in words, beginning to read a variety of texts, reading and writing high frequency words, grouping letters to form simple words, starting to write independently, interpreting simple instruction from teachers or peers and demonstrating attentive listening. Students will be encouraged to take risks and have a go in reading, writing and speaking and listening. Our English content will be linked to our Science topic.

In **Maths** students will participate in the Mathematical strands individually, in groups and as a whole class through a variety of activities. They will manipulate Mathematical materials exploring the concepts of:

Whole Number Multiplication & Division Time

3D Shape Fractions Mass

Length Data

This term we will be doing a **Science and Technology** unit titled 'Seasons and Changes'. Our History unit will continue from Term 1 particularly investigating what stories people tell about the past and how stories can be told.

Creative Arts- This term Kindergarten will be carrying out art using variety of media and skills linked to our Science topic.

PDHPE- This term's unit is titled Keeping Safe. Students will explore strategies and behaviours they can incorporate into their daily lives to maintain and promote their emotional, social and physical health and wellbeing.
