Student Bus Passes

2023 School Travel Applications are now open. Students who need a School Opal card or travel pass for 2023 <u>can apply now</u>. A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. shared custody).

Students who change address, school, campus location or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should renew or update their details before the end of Term 4. This will ensure that schools can endorse applications, and entitlements remain valid for the start of the 2023 school year. School Opal card holders will have the changes applied to their existing card.
