Bring Your Own Device Program

This week we sent a compass message to all parents of children in Years 3–5 re: the BYODD program. This program has been set up since 2019. Essentially, this means students in Years 4–6 have the option to bring in their own iPad to use in class and store all their work. Children can bring their iPad in anytime, and the teachers know how to set it up to connect to our system. Please see all the details (including purchase deals) on our website HERE.

Teacher Training - Coaching and ADHD courses



Teachers are required to constantly engage with professional learning throughout their career. This mainly happens after school and can take different forms. Our weekly Collaborative Coaching sessions in Maths with our AP Brenda Paul provides teachers with a forum to constantly check in with maths learning for their class and make decisions about learning for their pupils based on assessments and work samples. These sessions started in Term 2 and will continue into 2023.

This term all teachers are also completing 20 hours of a combination face to face/online learning course titled 'Understanding ADHD'. As teachers, we are not specifically trained to recognise, diagnose or identify various neurodiversity in learners, as there are professionals who do this. However, our experience of working with many diverse children means we need to be well informed and able to make adjustments in our classrooms. So far, we are all enjoying the course, learning a lot and having great discussions. As our presenter said, 'we are all singing from the same song sheet', which means more positive learning and playing experiences for all our students.
