This Week at Joeys

Tomorrow your Joey's semester 1 report will be available to view on Compass. The report is based on all assessments from Term 1 and 2. Assessments are not just 'tests' at the completion of a unit of work. Assessment in Primary school is ongoing, minute by minute, day by day, week by week, unit by unit. We measure and report against the NESA syllabus mandatory outcomes in subject areas. A teacher constantly makes observations, analyses work samples and notes observations to gather a picture of the learner and their achievements throughout the semester. These all feed into the report to parents.

You are also offered the opportunity to meet with the teacher to discuss your child's learning. For students in years 2–6 there is the opportunity to engage in a 3 way interview with parent teacher and student included. This is optional. It's all about students engaging in their learning journey by articulating their thoughts about their learning and goals. This link explains the purpose of a 3 way interview.
