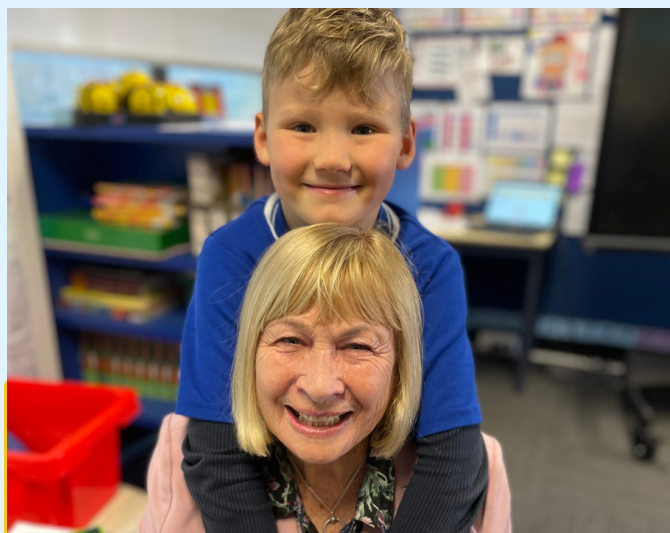


This Week at Joeys

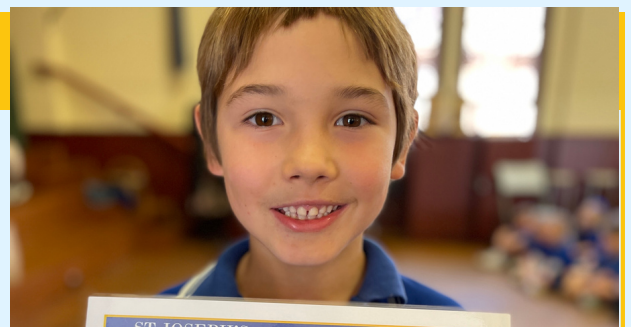
New School Records
