Parliament and Civics Education Rebate (PACER): Students from our school will soon be undertaking, an education tour of the national capital. There is no designated entry and exit sides and certainly parking in the drive through is selfish and dangerous. It is not the place to park, walk up to the school and wait for your child. The Kiss n Ride zone is convenient for that reason.
