You may have heard us reference that the NSW English and Maths syllabuses have been through a reform over the past few years. In 2023, K-2 classes implemented the teaching of the new syllabuses and this year, Years 3-6 are learning from the new curriculum.

The teachers have been participating in professional learning about the NSW reform and the new curriculum over the past three years, both as a school team and with our system.

NESA (New South Wales Education and Standards Authority) is the body that governs our syllabus creation, reform and implementation for all school systems in NSW. They have created parent guides for the new curriculums.

This week I share with you the Parent Guides for English (linked below). These may help you to understand better the essential skills and concepts of the English Curriculum and in turn help you to understand the areas we assess and report on. Semester 1 reports for 2024 will be published to Compass on Friday 21st June.

Respect: Our Core Value

Our core value for this term is Respect. Respect for ourselves, for others and the place you're in.

We are currently focusing on respectful behaviour in our classrooms and in the playground. Sadly, as a staff we have noticed a deterioration of respectful behaviour from the students to all teachers and adults in the school community. Some students choose to respect their classroom teacher, but are then disrespectful to a specialist teacher, the teachers on playground duty or the teacher's aides. This disrespect manifests as poor behaviour, not listening, speaking when the teacher is or answering back in a disrespectful way.

We have always prided ourselves on the respect that is shown between the adults in our school and the students. Indeed, it was what endeared me to this school when I first came.

In class, we will be talking and learning about respect and the expectations for all students. I ask that you support us to improve this aspect of behaviour by speaking with your children about what respect looks like. Teachers will contact you if your child repeatedly shows disrespect to others.

Friendology Program: Parent Tip

Should parents get involved in their kids' friendships?

The message that we want to give our children is, "You've got this!" not, "Don't worry, I've got this for you!"

Try thinking of yourself as a "Friendship Coach." Coaches don't go out there and play the game for their players. Instead, they give them advice and send them to play. Then, they stand back on the sidelines and watch. When they call their team in, they point out what they saw and give the players some tips and guidance. It should work that way with parents too, coaching your children through their triendships.

Rather than acting as lead negotiator in our children's relationships, we should support them and coach from the sidelines.
