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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Catholic Schools Broken Bay use a student-centred approach for K-2 Religious Education that has a focus on early years pedagogy. It uses rich hands-on resources to explore deep connections and continue to build each child's journey of faith.

ENGLISH

Continuing to create connections between **oral language, reading fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing** in our learning; underpinned by the latest international research of phonics and phonemic awareness.

This term we will focus on blending and segmenting sounds in words to assist with fluency when reading decodable texts.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics K-2, students:

- develop essential numeracy skills and mathematical fluency
- identify, describe and apply patterns and relationships
- develop their reasoning and problem-solving skills
- apply their knowledge and understanding in practical situations and make informed decisions.

GEOGRAPHY

People Live in Places, My Community

Students will continue to develop an understanding of what makes a place special and how this may differ for different people. Students will look outside of the place they know and what explore makes them special to others.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Weather in my world.

Our Science and Technology unit, titled 'Weather in my World,' asks students to explore seasons and how they affect our life; in the clothes we wear, the food we eat and the changes in the environment.

HOME LEARNING

Homework will be given to the children weekly in their Homework Folders. Their Homework Folders will be sent home on their Talk Time day and is to be returned on this day the following week. Children will continue to be given decodable readers this term as well as Homework Writing Journals.

Students will continue to explore our program Friendology where students learn strategies and skills to help them to become a good friend and keep friendships healthy.

CREATIVE ARTS

Kindergarten are exploring Visual Arts through seasons and weather, creating multi-media artworks that reflect this unit of work.

Music, Dance and Drama will be explored through specialist music lessons with Mr Warby and through integration into daily topics where students will express themselves through movement and role-playing.
