Traffic News: Update

Last year a number of concepts were proposed to update the traffic, parking and Kiss N Ride zones around school.

The council has been keeping us up to date on all the meetings that have occurred as the proposed traffic changes for the Safer Neighbourhoods program are presented and debated. The local traffic committee meeting takes place on May 6th to endorse the changes suggested. You can **take a look at this site** to see what the current proposals are.

There will be a significant increase in pedestrian safety for our community with the installation of a raised pedestrian crossing on Ocean St and a raised pedestrian crossing at Waterloo St near the church as well as a roundabout at Wellington and Lagoon St. There will also be a reduced speed limit to 40 at all times.
