Year 5

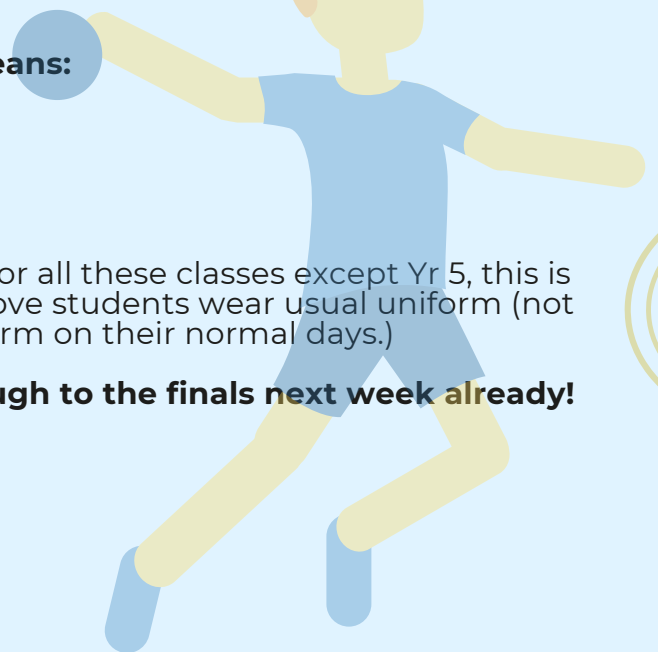
