## **Public Speaking Tips**

**Practice, Practice** – The more you say your speech out loud, the easier it gets. Try in front of a mirror, your pet, or a family member.

Take a Deep Breath - Before you start, breathe in slowly. It helps calm nerves and makes your voice clear.

**Stand Tall** – Good posture shows confidence. Imagine you're a superhero!

**Consider your pace** – Don't rush. Pauses are OK, they give your audience time to listen.

Make Eye Contact – Look at people's faces, not the floor. It helps you connect with your audience.

Use Your Hands - Gestures make your talk more interesting and help explain your points.

Have Fun! - Smile, enjoy yourself, and remember: everyone makes mistakes!.

Be a Good Listener - Make sure you're listening the same way you'd want someone to listen to you.



- 3. Select the date of Challenge you wish to attend and then click "Book Now"

- 5. Enter the number of children dancing and then click "Next"
- 6. Select "Buy More Tickets"
- 7. Scroll to your Schools spectator section
- 8. Enter the number of spectator seats you wish to purchase, then click on the seats and then click "Next"
- 9. Finalise your payment

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

**DRESS CODE:** We suggest that children wear attire that they feel most comfortable in and relevant to this special occasion. Please be mindful of footwear.

CATERING: If your children require food or drinks, they will need to bring it with them as they will not be able to leave their school area to go to parents at any time. Security guards will also not allow any commercially prepared food to be brought into the venue. Adults are NOT permitted to bring any alcohol inside the venue. There is an onsite cafe where parents and friends can purchase food throughout the night.

SECURITY: Once children are in the Arena, they are not allowed outside and must remain in their allocated school area. All children must be collected from the Main Arena area by a parent or authorised person. Children will not be allowed to leave the Arena to meet parents outside the venue.


