



TERM 3 CURRICULUM NOTE

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Students will engage in scripture presentations and wondering questions to allow them to deepen their faith and understand the teachings of Jesus.

MATHEMATICS

Students will learn about multiplication and division, 2D shapes and 3D objects, and build their thinking and problem-solving skills through daily reviews on previous topics such as addition, subtraction and place value.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Life Cycles

Students will explore how living things grow and change through their life cycles, supported by hands on learning and an excursion to the Australian Museum to deepen their understanding of plants and animals.

PDHPE

Students will continue to explore our Friendology program where they learn strategies and skills to help them to become a good friend and keep friendships healthy. In specialist Physical Education lessons, Mrs Frost will focus on gross motor activities.

ENGLISH

Students will deepen their skills in *oral language, reading fluency, comprehension, and writing* grounded in their understanding of **phonics** and **phonemic awareness**.

Students will focus on public speaking, culminating in presenting a prepared speech later in the term.

Geography

Connections to Country

Students will learn about the special connection First Nations Peoples have with Country and how their knowledge and traditions help care for the environment. Mrs Fogwell and Mrs Paul will teach this.

CREATIVE ARTS

In visual arts students will create artworks inspired by plant and animal life cycles, using line, colour and texture to show growth and change. Dance will be taught through specialist lessons with Mrs Paul.
