



TERM 3 CURRICULUM NOTE

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Students will engage and explore the Christian call to holiness - which is received at Baptism. Students will identify, in their experience, people who demonstrate holiness and use their gifts in love and service.

MATHEMATICS

Students will focus on developing mathematical fluency through the following topics:

- 3D spatial structure
- Angles
- Place value
- 2D shapes
- Multiplicative thinking

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Earth, Sun and Space

The unit focuses on the Earth's surface and how it changes over time. Students investigate natural processes and human activity to develop a view in relation to sustainable practices.

PDHPE

Students will explore our Friendology program where they learn strategies and skills to help them to become a good friend and keep friendships healthy.

There will also be a unit on Child Protection. A permission note will be sent through Compass. In specialist Physical Education lessons, Mrs Frost will focus on gross motor skills.

ENGLISH

Students will deepen their skills in *oral language, reading fluency, comprehension, writing, spelling, handwriting and digital transcription and understanding and responding to literature*. They will also focus on public speaking and prepare and present a speech.

Students will learn about characterisation through the text *Rowan of Rin* by Emily Rodda and perspective and context through the texts *Sadako and The Thousand Paper Cranes* by Eleanor Coerr and *Malala's Magic Pencil* by Malala Yousafzai.

Geography

Comparing Australia to its Neighbours

Students will explore the key similarities and differences between Australia and neighbouring countries through their natural, managed, and constructed features. This will be taught by Mrs Carolan and Mrs Fogwell.

CREATIVE ARTS

In Visual Arts, students will explore objects through drawing, sculpture and 3D forms.

Dance will be taught through specialist lessons with Mrs Paul.
